# 1. Grievances:

# 98-02, 98-27 & 98-30: C. Slagle - RE: S&A Benefits, Work & Seniority

- **USC** All three (3) grievances are resolved.
- USC Will consider the draft document was handed out addressing issues, such as working days, that arose from these grievances.

#### 98-25: D. Duvall & 98-28 M. Croy: Vacation Allotments

• Per USC: 98-28 is resolved based on vacation scheduling guidelines in place on #1&2 Paper Machines. 98-25 is still open awaiting a meeting with 3&4 Paper Machine Management.

#### 98-32: M. Mitchell

• **USC** - Third step meeting to be scheduled upon receipt of additional information.

#### 98-37: D. Casper – Written Reprimand

• **USC** - Will hold for Worker's Comp hearing on February 3<sup>rd</sup>.

#### 98-43: D. Johnson - Written Reprimand

- USC Requests a correction of the last meeting minutes. The apology is for the wording of the letter, not the content or message.
- **D. Johnson** will have a discussion with **M. Woods** and **C. Warren** on January 21, 1999. (Note: subsequent to the meeting, the letter of discussion was rescinded thereby resolving this case.)

#### **98-44:** B. Vanderpool -

- MSC No Worker's Comp. has been filed and this issues does not qualify for FMLA.
- USC If a supervisor lets someone go home because he has sufficient coverage then it is treated as a leave of absence. The 8 hour absence triggered an absence-related reprimand. The pay is not the issue, but the 8 hours that triggered the reprimand is the issue.
- MSC Will discuss
- **USC** Their position is that the broken tooth is Worker's Comp related.
- MSC Disagrees that this is work related. After considering the specifics of this situation, the MSC agreed to rescind the reprimand and removed the 8 hour absence from the grievant's attendance record.
- USC States that the grievance is resolved.

# 98-45 & 46: R. Manthe & D. Brown - Investigation

- USC Presented a letter concerning issues related to the investigation.
- MSC Agrees with some points in the letter and emphasized that the company has the obligation to investigate these types of incidents. MSC will meet with **B. Fehlen** and **T. Winn**. Both Union and Company agree with the statement that we can't condone any form of property damage.

#### 99-01: L. Cottrell - Disciplinary Action

• USC - Sprinkler has been broken in the past. There is a yellow stripe with a rule that not more than 8 boards be stacked in this area. Grievant does not stack the boards, she just pulls the product off of them. Since there was more than 8 boards she was forced to have the forklift mast up in the lights and water piping.

# **Unnumbered Grievance**

- **USC** A 1<sup>st</sup> step grievance letter was sent to **C. Lang** on 12-24-98 regarding G. Anderson has been not been answered.
- **MSC** Will follow-up.

# 2. Meal Ticket Restaurants

- Three (3) new restaurants have been added -
- USC Requests that Laurlei's be added. They have converted to all Fort James paper products and will deliver hot meals to the mill.
- The Brass Rail will be deleted due to restaurant closure.

# 3. Chip Test

• MSC - Eliminating nightshift chip testers, on or about February 1, 1999. No other schedule changes. D. Weaver's request to go below Cross and Hegnes will be allowed by the USC if it does not result in other problems. C. Lang to canvas the people involved.

#### 4. Violence in the Workplace

• K. Larson will schedule a follow-up meeting with those who attended.

#### 5. JSC Meetings

• Could move to Tuesday, but prefer to have meetings on Wednesday.

#### **6.** Union 401(k)

• MSC - requests local to vote on plan.
