

STANDING COMMITTEE – 10/26/99 MEETING MINUTES

- The Joint Standing Committee met today to discuss questions arising from the Napkin Consumer operators as a result of scheduling laid-off Box Facial employees to do quickstocking on No. 47 Napkin Folder. The notes below report the JSC answers to those questions.

1. *What is the definition of quickstock?*

Answer: Manual labor required to build quickstock units, i.e.: taping, stacking, stretch wrapping, etc.

2. *Are quickstock jobs part of any progression ladder?*

Answer: No, given above definition of Q/S.

3. *Does management have the right to schedule employees from the Labor Pool to do quickstock jobs as defined above.*

Answer: Yes

4. *What will be done to ensure the ergonomic safety of Consumer operators?*

Answer: Rotation will occur with the Nos. 45 and/or 44 operators, and the Ergonomic Team will review the No. 47 operator/taping job and will recommend a rotation schedule.

5. *Will the laborers who are scheduled to do the quickstock be used in the rotation of the regular consumer operators?*

Answer: No
