## **Steve Francouer:**

Steve talked about what happened on boiler. WE had lots of learning events during the last month. 1 recordable during outage and 1 contractor recordable. PH issue going into the outage. We have been good at reporting contractor issues on ISN network. Major change in the procedure in boiler is if it goes down for more than 6 hours they will water wash the boiler until everything is removed. We really got lucky that all we damaged was metal. The other impact from the boiler is the cost of 1 million dollars. So we are outing on hold a lot of new projects in the mill. In total with the unplanned events that happened the total cost is around 5 million.
